PRESENT TENSE

The present tense is used for actions which are happening now.





PRESENT CONTINUOUS TENSE

PRESENT CONTINUOUS TENSE

The present continuous tense is used for talking about actions or things that are going on or happening at the present time.

USES AND EXAMPLES

1. To express an action that is going on at the time of speaking.



George is **eating**.

USES AND EXAMPLES

2. To express an action expected to take place in the immediate future.



I am **preparing** a special dish tomorrow.

USES AND EXAMPLES

3. To express an action taking place at the present time but not necessarily at the time of speaking.



They are **constructing** an office complex here.

KEEP IN MIND



sentence format
subject + is/am/are +
present participle
(V1+ing) + object
eg: Tony is dancing.



negative sentences
subject + is/am/are +
not + present participle
(V1+ing) + object
eg: They are not
studying.



interrogative sentences
is/am/are + subject +
present participle
(V1+ing) + object
eg: Are you sleeping in
the class?
